


Instructions:

- Print off the attached sample bingo card — or create your own.
- Randomly assign the numbers 1 to 25 so each cell has a unique number. Write the number in the top left corner of each box, leaving most of the box empty.
- Each week, we will send out a numbered list of 25 things to see/hear.
- When you observe each item, mark the number from the list into whatever cell you've assigned that number to. *(So if "catkin" is #3 on our list, Hazel would mark the date and location of her catkin sighting into whatever square she has pre-marked as #3.)*
- A "Bingo!" is any line of five.
